



Pesticide drift occurs when pesticides applied to one agricultural field "spread" into other places like:

- ◆ other fields
- ◆ surrounding yards
- ◆ surrounding homes and buildings

When pesticides are applied to fields near your home from planes, tractors or backpack sprayers, you should:

- ... go inside.
- ... call children inside.
- ... take in any laundry.
- ... close your windows.
- ... close the cover on your bar-b-cue (even if you are not cooking).
- ... have children do indoor chores or play inside.
- ... cover or empty and refill your child's wading pool.
- ... wash home grown vegetables thoroughly.
