Duke University School of Medicine invites applications and nominations for Chair of the Department of Medicine. Candidates should have a strong background in academic medicine, including a track record of excellence in patient care, medical education, and research, and significant experience as a physician leader in a first-rate academic setting.

The Department of Medicine at Duke has a long history of distinction, with cutting-edge clinical programs, nationally recognized graduate and undergraduate medical education programs, and innovative clinical, translational, and laboratory research efforts. The Department currently consists of approximately 430 clinical and research faculty, 140 subspecialty and post-doctoral fellows, and 160 residents, and is engaged in collaborative efforts across Duke University School of Medicine, Duke University Health System, and the entire Duke University campus. Current extramural research support in the Department exceeds \$250 million per year.

Duke University School of Medicine is among the top research medical schools in the country, annually ranked among the top 5 schools in funding from the National Institutes of Health and in the top 10 schools by U.S. News and World Report. The signature clinical facility in Duke University Health System is Duke University Hospital, a Magnet hospital that is consistently ranked in the top ten by U.S. News and World Report.

The successful candidate should have an MD or MD/PhD, academic credentials that qualify for appointment at the level of Professor with tenure, board certification in Internal Medicine, and eligibility for a license to practice medicine in North Carolina.
