### Pesticide Safety Lesson 3: Clean Them Out!

#### **What the participant should know by the end of the lesson:**

- The areas in her home where her child/ren may be exposed to pesticides
- How to clean pesticides out of her home
- How to wash dirty work clothes

#### **Materials:**

- Handout: *Pesticide Exposure Mapping*
- Stickers: *El Terror Invisible*
- Handout: *Cleaning Pesticides from your Home*
- Handout: *The Farmworker's Guide to Laundering Work Clothes*

#### **Help the participant identify areas in her home where her child/ren may be exposed to pesticides and think of ways to remove pesticides from those areas.**

##### **Assessment:**

- Where do you think your child might be exposed to pesticides in your home?
- What can you do in those areas to reduce your child's exposure to pesticides?

##### **Activity:**

Do the *Pesticide Exposure Mapping* exercise with the *El Terror Invisible* stickers.  
Review brochure, *Cleaning Pesticides from your Home*.

##### **Reflection:**

- What did you learn from the mapping activity?
- How do you feel about the possibility that your child could be exposed to pesticides inside your home?

#### **Help the participant find ways to do laundry that reduce her family's exposure to pesticides.**

##### **Assessment:**

- What is your current laundry routine?
- Where are dirty work clothes stored in your house?

##### **Activity:**

- Review *The Farmworker's Guide to Washing Work Clothes*.

##### **Reflection:**

- How can you change your laundry routine to protect your child from pesticide exposure?
- What was the most useful thing that you learned in today's discussion?
