

2009 Graylyn Conference on Women's Cognitive Health Poster Submission & Presentation Guidelines

Submission Process

1. Abstracts of one page or less should be emailed to whcoe@wfubmc.edu.
2. Abstracts and posters should address the following areas of your research:
Hypothesis/Objectives, Background, Methods/Design, Results, Conclusions.
3. Include the full names, credentials, and departments of each author.
4. 12-point Arial font preferred on abstracts, with 1 inch margins.
5. Abstract submission deadline: September 11, 2009.

Notification Process

You will be notified by email by September 18, 2009.

Poster Display

If your poster is accepted, you will be provided with an easel and a 3x5' foam board for mounting your poster. In addition, thumbtacks, double-sided tape, binder clips will be provided to keep your poster in place.

We prefer that posters are not oversized, because there will not be adequate space to accommodate them.

General Poster Tips

1. Font should be large enough to read from 6 feet away.
2. Use the same font throughout the poster.
3. The title should be large enough to read from 20 feet away.
4. Try to organize materials in columns or in a clockwise direction.
5. Use only graphics that are necessary.
