Summer Radiology Review 2010 Target Audience & Objectives

This course is intended for practicing radiologists. At the conclusion of this CME activity, the participants should be better able to:

- Recognize unique injuries in the female athlete and imaging findings of musculoskeletal pathology in the hand, wrist, and lower extremity.

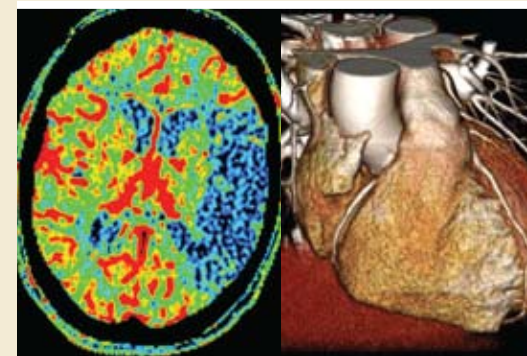
