Hormone Therapies

There are many different hormone therapies available. Below are generic and brand name hormone therapies.

Estrogens

Generic Name (*Brand Name*)

- ▶ Esterified estrogens (*Menest, Estratab*)
- ▶ Estradiol (*Estrace*)
- ▶ Estradiol transdermal system (*Alora, Climara, Esclim, Estraderm, FemPatch, Vivelle, Vivelle Dot*)
- ▶ Estradiol valerate (*Delestrogen, Gynogen L.A. 20, Estra-L 40, Valergen 20, Valergen 40*)
- ▶ Estradiol cypionate (*depGynogen, Dep-Estradiol, Cypionate, DepoGen*)
- ▶ Estrogens, conjugated (*Premarin, C.E.S., Congest*)
- ▶ Estrogens, synthetic conjugated (*Cenestin*)
- ▶ Estrone (*Kestrone 5, EstraGyn 5*)
- ▶ Estropipate (*Ogen, Ortho-Est*)
- ▶ Ethinyl estradiol (*Estinyl*)

Hormone Combinations (Estrogen + Progestin)

Generic Name (*Brand Name*)

- ▶ Estradiol + norethindrone (*Activella*)
- ▶ Estradiol + norethindrone: Transdermal patch (*CombiPatch*)
- ▶ Esterified estrogen + methyltestosterone (*Estratest*)
- ▶ Esterified estrogen + methyltestosterone (*Estratest H.S.*)
- ▶ Ethinyl estradiol + norethindrone (*FemHRT 1/5*)
- ▶ Estradiol + norgestimate (*Ortho-Prefest*)
- ▶ Conjugated estrogens + medroxyprogesterone (*Premphase*)
- ▶ Conjugated estrogens + medroxyprogesterone (*Prempro*)
- ▶ Medroxyprogesterone acetate (*Depo-Provera*)
- ▶ Norethindrone (*Aygestin, Norlutate*)
- ▶ Progesterone, micronized (*Prometrium*)
