images.MD

images.MD is a collection of over 45,000 medical pictures, derived from Current Medicine's series of illustrated atlases. Graphics include histology, pathology, radiographs, original artwork, graphs, and tables. You can use these to create slides, supplement lectures, or create handouts for educational presentations. Any slide from the **imagesMD** collection can be saved, copied and emailed to others. Each image comes with descriptive text and a referenced source. Choose from the Cardiology, Critical Care, Dermatology, Embryology, Infectious Disease, Pulmonary collections, to name just a few. Faculty of 1000

Faculty of 1000 is a literature awareness tool developed by scientists and published by BioMed Central. Disciplines covered are Biochemistry, Bioinformatics, Biotechnology, Genomics & Genetics, Immunology, Microbiology, Molecular Medicine, Neuroscience, and more. Over 1000 leading researchers in biology evaluate and comment on 2-4 papers each month. They often cite related articles, with links within their comments. Any article from a PubMed journal to which the Carpenter Library subscribes electronically is available by clicking on the PubMed link attached to the Faculty of 1000 citation. Other papers can be ordered through an online delivery system and emailed to the requestor. **Faculty of 1000** is located on the Library's web site at "Health Professionals/Researchers—Electronic Resources," or at

PrimateLit

The PrimateLit database, a collaborative project of the Wisconsin and Washington Primate Research Centers, provides bibliographic access to scientific literature on nonhuman primates for research and educational communities. Coverage spans from 1940 to present. It includes all publication categories (articles, books, abstracts, technical reports, dissertations, book chapters) and many subject areas (behavior, colony management, ecology, reproduction, field studies, disease models, veterinary science, psychology, physiology, pharmacology, evolution, taxonomy, developmental and molecular biology, genetics and zoogeography).
